2018 FIRST SEMESTER EXAM SCHEDULE

1. Each Exam Day has **five** 70-minute class periods. The first daily exam period begins at 8:00 a.m. and the last one ends at 2:55 p.m. Students in grades 9-12 are required to be at EMS only for the periods in which their classes are scheduled to meet—as outlined on the Exam Schedule.
2. Not every class will have an exam or activity scheduled during the two days of exam. If your class is listed under the “Classes with Alternative Plans,” then that teacher will use the class days prior to the exam period for a culminating activity.
3. Students in grades 9-12 who choose to be in school at times other than when their classes meet, according to the exam schedule, must be in the Library studying, working in another classroom under the supervision of a teacher, or in the gym (if it is open). **OPEN GYM TIMES ARE MARKED ON THE EXAM SCHEDULE.** The Commons will also be open during the exam periods. If you wish to study in larger groups, we ask that you gather in the Commons.
4. Library “open” policy during exam days will be posted on the library door. The Library is intended to be used as a quiet study area only.
5. **DRESS CODE IS REQUIRED DURING EXAM DAYS.**
6. In the case of two exams scheduled for the same period, students are to make arrangements with the teachers involved.
7. If you happen to have **more than three exams** scheduled for one day, you will be permitted to adjust your schedule so that you have no more than three. Keep in mind that some courses use the exam slot for presentations or other activities. If you do have **four or five exams**, please see the School Counselors or Mrs. Patsy Seitz.
8. **Out of Schedule Exams**: Teachers and administration expect students to be present during exam periods. If families have reasons beyond their control that require a student to take an exam or complete work prior to the scheduled exam days, **the school requests that families notify Mrs. Seitz by December 1.** Mrs. Seitz will then communicate with teachers so that alternative plans can be created for the student.
9. **IN CASE OF SNOW OR ICE DURING EXAM DAYS**: If we have one or more snow days during the exam schedule (December 19-20), we will proceed as follows: the exams missed because of the snow day(s) will be given on the next day that school is in session with the rest of exam days and the beginning of second semester to follow in that order.

Middle School

Middle School students will begin Christmas break after school on Tuesday, December 18. Middle School classes will **NOT** meet on December 19-20. Most middle school students taking high school level classes will be tested in the days prior to the exam schedule.
